

Dustin Moore's restoration story:

This year I will be displaying my 1940 Allis Chalmers Model B. This tractor has been in the Moore family for decades.



In August of 2016, I hauled the tractor (which was no longer running due to a seized motor) off my grandfather's property in NH with the intention of rebuilding it for him. The initial intent was to have the tractor completed when he returned from Florida in the spring (he and my grandmother are annual snow birds). Unfortunately, due to a few medical set-backs they were not able to leave in the fall and hung around for Christmas 2016. Once the decision was made that they were staying for Christmas, the rush was on. It was the perfect opportunity to give it to him as a Christmas gift. So, Christmas eve 2016 the Moore family got together and it was given to him.... He and my grandmother were both blown away.
